This fine setting is from the Colby notebooks, penned by the singing master William Shepherd in the Isle of Man during the early decades of the 19th Century. It has been found in no printed source. There is good reason to believe that bars 1-5 soprano are a later addition by a less skilled hand than that of the anonymous composer, and the editorial recommendation is that they be omitted in performance. Shepherd's normal performance style was tenor-led unaccompanied singing.
