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Joseph Hart, according to his own account, was converted from "dissolute" ways by a sermon in the Moravian Chapel in Fetter Lane, London on Whit Sunday 1757. He was minister of Jewin Street Independent Chapel from 1859. Amongst Independent hymn writers he was second in popularity only to Isaac Watts.
