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Editorial emendations:

Transposed up a tone.

Bar 6, Tenor: dotted c' and b amended from c' and b to conform with bar 1.

Bar 11, Alto: Jc' amended from Jb (presumably a misprint).

Bar 12, Tenor: I amended from I (presumably a misprint).

Bar 12, Alto: $rac{d}{f}$ amended from $rac{d}{c}$ to avoid parallel octaves with the Treble, and parallel fifths with the Tenor. Bar 17, Verse 3 text: "world was" amended from "word 'twas".

This tune was originally set to Psalm XLIV by Thomas Sternhold.

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
