'Jesus shall reign where-e'er the Sun' is a paraphrase of part of Psalm 72 by Isaac Watts, from *The Psalms of David Imitated in the Language of the New Testament* published in 1719. The book went through 15 editions in Watts' lifetime, with the last of these in 1748 being used here.

'Truro' was published in *Musica Sacra* for three voices (Alto, Tenor and Bass) in 1788, then in *Psalmodia Evangelica, Vol. II* in 1789, with the Alto part being replaced with a Soprano part. This edition uses both sources to provide all four parts. The symphony is from Benjamin Jacob's *National Psalmody*, 1819; the top line is marked 'Trumpet'.

Editorial emendations :

Bars 10 & 18, Alto : second note e'

Bars 12 & 20, Soprano : second note f'

Tranposed down a tone from *Musica Sacra*, and a minor third from *Psalmodia Evangelica*. The repeat is present only in *Musica Sacra*, and has been written in full for this edition.

There are a number of consecutive fifths and octaves, which have been left uncorrected.
