LGQ 176 Angels from the realms of glory

Symphony as intro, between verses and at end. mf thoughout verses; chorus: cut short crochets in bar 22 & 24 before band ornaments. Start f, at B p, over bars 41-3 cresc to f. v3 unaccomp, band rejoin for chorus omit v4

LGQ 300 Shepherds arise, be not afraid

Symphony from last beat bar 29-end as intro, between verses and at end. v2 unaccomp, band rejoin for chorus. v1 mf v2 p v3 mf v4 mf Chorus always f, strict minims in bars 19 & 20 before band ornaments

LGQ 378 Hark, shepherds, how the angels sing

Symphony as intro, between verses and at end *mf* throughout, v3 unaccompanied

AUDIENCE SINGS

LGQ 677 Christians awake, salute the happy morn Full play through as intro. Symphony between verses and at end. Four verses.

LGQ 496 No kingly robes nor golden treasure

Symphony from bar 15 to end as intro, between verses and at end Verses 1-3 *mp*, v4 *mf* v2 Solo+(quiet) band

Reading

LGQ 557 Hush, be still, the Holy Infant sleeps

Flute solo symphony on soprano line (bar 9-end) as intro, between verses, and at end. v2 unaccomp, sung by altos, all others hum mp throughout

LGQ 598 Have you not heard our Saviour's love?

Chord start *mf* throughout v3 unaccomp. Omit v4 cut short crochets in bar 9 & 10 before band ornaments

LGQ 698 Lo! He comes, an Infant Stranger

Chord start. verses mf chorus f v2 unaccomp, band rejoin for chorus

LGQ 674 While Shepherds watch'd their Flocks by Night

Symphony as intro, between verses and at end *mf* throughout v1 unison, v4 unaccomp. strict minims in bars 8 & 18 before band ornaments

LGQ 697 Hark! What means those heavenly voices

Chord start. Start mf, from bar 21 f Band play quietly during solo & duet basr 13-20

AUDIENCE SINGS LGQ 209 God rest ye merry, gentlemen Full play through as intro. v1 unison Omit v4 v5 unaccomp.

LGQ 696 Ich steh an deiner krippen hier

Chord start. v1-2 mp v3 mf v2 unaccomp
